Epilepsy: Board Review

To be qualified as a licensed medical subspecialist after medical residency and fellowship training, we must pass a Subspecialty Board Examination. This review book is written for you for this purpose.

This book contains 383 board-type multiple choice questions and has been structured into 4 sections: (1) phenomenology of seizure and epileptic disorders containing 71 questions; (2) basic electroencephalography (EEG) containing 77 questions; (3) diagnosis of seizure and epilepsy containing 80 questions; and (4) treatment of seizures and epilepsy contains 135 questions. Each question is closely related to clinical practice and each answer to

questions has detailed explanations and is linked with useful reference.

This book cannot replace a textbook, nor a comprehensive hands-on training experience. However, I believe that this book will be useful for those who are preparing for their Board Examination and Board Re-Certification related to Epilepsy field. It may also be useful for a fellow to prepare for their in-service exam to enhance their training. Additionally, it may help attending physicians who teach fellows, neurology residents, and medical students dealing with the issues of seizures, epilepsy and EEG from basic concepts to clinical management.
